About Tradewater

Tradewater's mission is to improve the environment and create economic opportunity through the collection, control, and destruction of potent, high-impact greenhouse gases. Tradewater is a deeply mission-driven company that believes that a company committed to cleaning up the environment can be just as successful – if not more so – than a company that achieves its goals without regard to environmental impact.

To date, Tradewater has prevented more than 5.5 million metric tons of carbon dioxide equivalent from being released into the atmosphere, a key step in the fight against climate change. Much of this impact has come from the identification, collection, and destruction of old refrigerants that are both ozone depleting substances and potent greenhouse gases. Now, Tradewater is scaling its operations and building a global team capable of preventing more than 3 million tons of CO₂e from being released to the atmosphere annually. Achieving this goal involves identifying, controlling, and destroying potent greenhouse gases around the world and building a diversified market that values the climate benefits Tradewater creates.

The Opportunity

To support its growth around the world, Tradewater seeks to hire a consultant based in India to support its efforts in the country and the broader South Asia region. The consultant will be asked to identify opportunities to find and procure old refrigerants at the end of their useful life, and help design the systems and build the partnerships needed to have them safely destroyed according to published carbon offset protocols.

The contract position is expected to last for a period of six months with the possibility to extend this period based on project progress and results. It is required that the consultant live and be qualified to work in India but available to travel throughout India and South Asia, including Bangladesh. The consultant will report to Tradewater's Senior Manager of Projects and New Developments.

Key responsibilities include:

- Conduct exploration activities under Tradewater's guidelines to identify ozone-depleting refrigerants and halons (ODS) in the shipbreaking industry and HVAC sector.
- Research and collect relevant data about the market for ODS in India and volumes available for collection.

- Investigate and map key stakeholders in all relevant sectors and meet with them, as appropriate, to understand what it takes to acquire ODS in India.
- Negotiate deals to acquire identified ODS from local stakeholders and prepare required purchase documents.
- Assess the opportunity to build a broader, ongoing program in India and make strategic recommendations about how to develop such a program.
- In coordination with the Projects and New Developments team, conduct the same types of exploration activities to assess project potential in other countries in South Asia.
- Keep a detailed record of all the information collected in accordance with Tradewater's guidelines.
- Submit regular reports on all progress made and the results of all exploration activities.

Education and Experience:

- Qualified applicants must:
 - Have a bachelor's degree or better, preferably in Environmental, Mechanical, Chemical or Industrial Engineering (or equivalent).
 - Have at least 5 years of experience in a relevant field.
 - Speak and write English fluently.
- Experience in environmental project management is desirable.
- Knowledge of refrigeration and air conditioning sector, and international work are considered helpful but not required.
- Ability to speak additional languages commonly spoken in South Asia is a plus.

Additional Qualifications:

- Demonstrated ability to work in a professional environment.
- Attention to detail is a must.
- Curiosity and creativity.
- Proven experience working remotely and independently.
- Ability to work nights, as needed, to coordinate with team members in different time zones around the world.
- Ability to complete tasks thoroughly and according to specific guidelines.
- Ability to strictly follow protocols and rules.
- Ability to synthesize information in a clear and well-structured manner.
- Excellent organizational skills.
- A results-driven attitude and a desire to achieve ambitious goals.
- Passion towards sustainable development and climate change.
- Commitment to Tradewater's mission.
