[Tradewater](#) is a B Corp and mission-based project development company that is in business to prevent catastrophic climate change. Our mission is to improve the environment and create economic opportunity through the collection, control, and destruction of potent, non-CO2 greenhouse gases. Tradewater believes that a company committed to cleaning up the environment can be just as successful – if not more so – than a company that achieves its goals without regard to environmental impact.

Non-CO2 gases account for nearly half of all global warming from human activity since 1970. Our work, referred to as “emergency brake solutions” by [Project Drawdown](#), is essential to prevent catastrophic climate change. Our projects include the destruction of refrigerants and halon fire suppressants that are potent greenhouse gases and deplete the ozone layer. We also find, measure, and plug orphaned oil and gas wells that have no solvent operator and are leaking methane into the atmosphere. To date, we have permanently prevented over 6.9 million tons of CO2e from reaching the atmosphere and we are on a path to surpass 27 million tons of CO2e by the end of 2027.

The Opportunity

The Carbon Project Manager will manage the monitoring, reporting, validation, and verification of a set of Tradewater’s carbon offset projects. All of Tradewater’s projects are conducted in accordance with strict performance, monitoring, and reporting requirements established by leading carbon offset registries, and this position will ensure Tradewater’s compliance with those requirements. The Carbon Project Manager will interface with a diverse range of project partners and facility operators, monitor project development and operational status, manage project data and documentation, and conduct compliance reporting. Additionally, the Carbon Project Manager will be responsible for working collaboratively on project development, operations, and logistics programs with other departments and team members.

Candidates should have a strong interest in market-based environmental businesses. They should possess excellent written and verbal communication skills, and have strong analytical skills. Candidates must be highly organized with fine attention to detail. The ideal candidate will have excellent problem-solving skills, basic proficiency with modern programming languages and platforms, and experience employing databases and data analysis procedures. They must also be proficient with Microsoft Office. Professional experience with industrial and environmental monitoring systems, database management, compliance reporting, project information management systems, or carbon offset protocols and methodologies is required.

While Tradewater is based in Chicago, we have offices and team members around the world. The Carbon Project Manager position is primarily remote, however candidates must be available, able and willing to travel according to the requirements listed below, including internationally as needed.

Applications for this position will be accepted through **February 23, 2024**.

Key responsibilities include:

- Work as a part of a team of professionals that is building a pipeline of global projects that will identify, collect, control and destroy harmful refrigerants and prevent the release of methane.
- Manage the monitoring, reporting, validation, and verification components of Tradewater's carbon offset projects for timely and successful carbon credit generation per protocols established under internationally recognized programs and registries (including but not limited to ACR at Winrock International, California Air Resources Board Compliance Offset Program, Climate Action Reserve, Verra's Verified Carbon Standard, and Washington Ecology's Cap-and-Invest Offsets program).
- Develop and maintain quality assurance and quality control of operations processes, compliance documentation, information management databases, and data reporting tools to facilitate efficient and effective project management schemes.
- Coordinate with internal stakeholders to ensure that projects are implemented in accordance with standard operating procedures, both established and under development, that ensure project success.
- Manage ongoing relationships with project partners, verifiers, registries, programs, and facility operators.

Requirements:

- Minimum BS/BA in environmental science, engineering, information science, or related field.
- Three or more years of project management experience.
- Prior experience with validation and verification of project greenhouse gas statements under environmental commodity programs (such as carbon offset registries, low carbon fuel programs, renewable energy trading schemes, or other similar environmental programs and frameworks).
- Strong quantitative and analytical skills with a high attention to process, organization, and detail.
- Strong written and oral communication skills with past experiences in communicating technical subject matter.
- Ability to work independently as well as collaboratively with team members and Tradewater partners.
- Patience to tolerate bureaucratic processes and the excitement and fortitude to persevere.
- Past experiences working across cultures and in different countries is highly desired.
- Fluent in English.
- Availability and willingness to travel internationally on occasion (current estimate to be as many as 5-8 trips per year) in support of verification activities.
- Committed to Tradewater's mission and brings a broader understanding of industry and overall landscape.
